## Winter Weather Safety



### Frostbite

Frostbite can happen when you are exposed to extremely cold temperatures and muscle tissue begins to freeze. Symptoms include pain, skin discoloration, and/or blistering of skin.



### Hypothermia

Hypothermia can happen when you are exposed to extremely cold temperatures, and your internal body temperature begins to drop. Symptoms include shivering, slurred speech, and/or drowsiness.



### When going outside, make sure to:

- Wear clothing that covers the nose, ears, toes, cheeks, chin, and fingers
- Use water-resistant clothing when possible
- Remove any clothing articles that are wet or frozen
